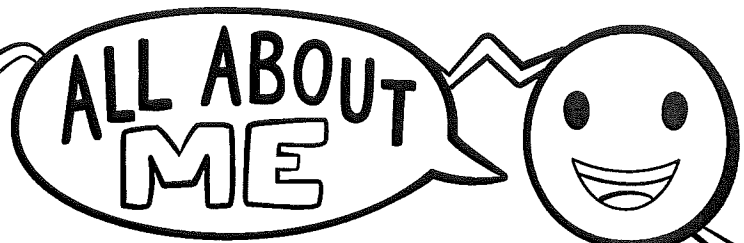
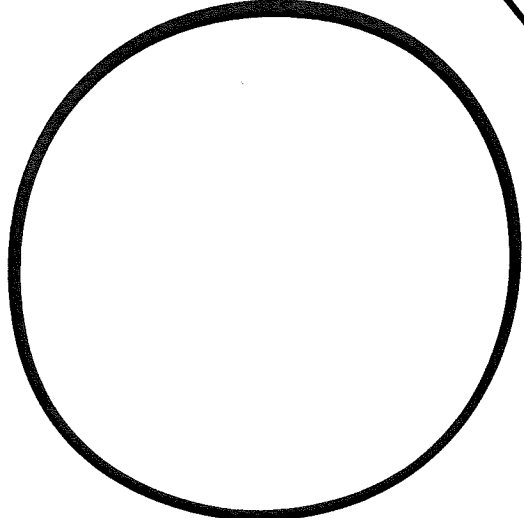
- Grades will be updated as tasks are given. Please check PowerSchool frequently to stay on top of your child's progress.

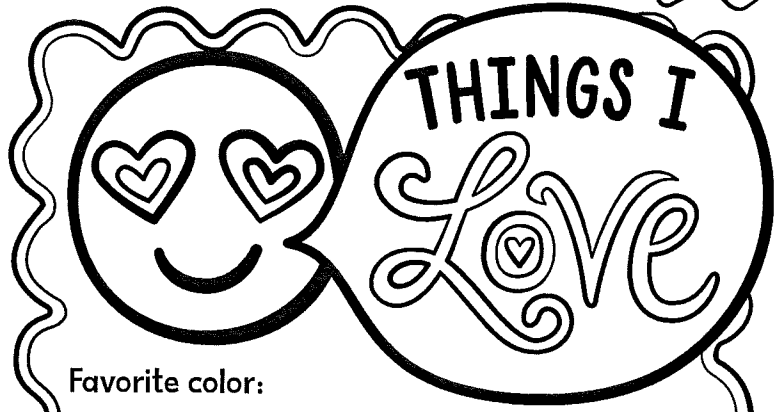
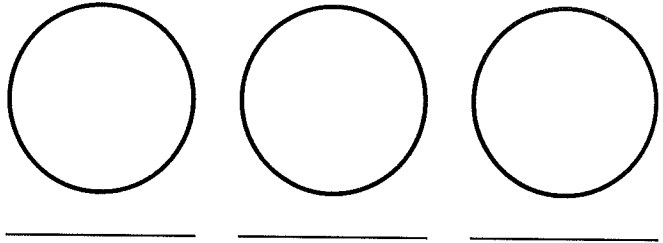

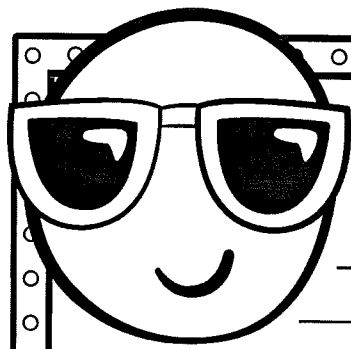
